This funding will be used to

- Enable 100% of students in Year 3 and Year 5 to achieve National Minimum Standard in reading, spelling and writing.
- Ensure Year 5 Mean Scale Scores for Writing are above the national average.
- Ensure 100% of students participating in the targeted reading intervention program show improvement from their pre to their post test result.

Our initiatives include

- Employ additional Support Teacher: Literacy and Numeracy in Years 3-6.
- Employ teacher to analyse data in the areas of writing and numeracy, then implement a writing and numeracy enhancement program for students identified in the Upper Three Bands.
- Employ experienced reading teacher who will mentor graduate teachers and teachers who identify the teaching of reading in their Annual Performance Review. This teacher will also work specifically with students identified as being below the National Minimum Standard in reading.
- Provide professional development and resources for class teachers to improve pedagogy in the classroom in the teaching of writing.
- Provide professional development in the use of collecting and analysing student spelling data, then planning targeted teaching around identified areas of need.
- Provide all classrooms with 2 hour blocks of teacher aide time, four days a week. These aides will target reading intervention as well as spelling and writing support.
- Develop teacher aide expertise (using the Master Teacher and Expert Reading Teacher) in the areas of reading, spelling and writing support for students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employ experienced teacher of reading to support beginning teachers, teachers requesting support and teacher aides. Supporting resources will be purchased.	\$61,439
Employ teacher to work with students in the Upper Three Bands.	\$60,405
Employ additional teacher aides so each class teacher has an aide for a 2hr block, 4 days a week. These aides will focus on reading, writing and spelling.	\$75,250
Employ additional STLaN teacher aide to support students at risk of not achieving National Minimum Standard and who are on Individual Curriculum Plans.	\$30,327
